

This does work. Why have the option to not use the tokin if it is required to use a token? In version 10.2 the port was not included in the URL. In 10.2.1 the port has to be included. However, for this to work in 10.2.1 ArcGIS Server the service folder that contains the feature access service must be shared to public if the ArcGIS Server security is set to use Windows Active Directory.



When I attempt to get a token I get the dialog you describe. But I don't know if I'm entering a userID/password that makes sense. The ArcGIS Server instance is using Windows Active Directory for authentication. In the dialog for generating the token I enter a windows AD domain ID and password and I do prefix the ID with the domain name (DOMAIN\USERID). Anyhow, I enter the generated token but the connection is not successful.





The two connections with the Green status arrow are NOT using tokens.
